	The school is directed to ensure that :				
1.	The total number of section of the school after upgradation, shall be restricted to 19 (As per prescribed dimension) out of which, not more than 1/3rd sections may be used to run Senior Secondary classes and further increase shall be subjected to specific approval of the Board on the basis of the request of the school as per affiliation bye laws.				
2	The total number of sections after up gradation shall be restricted to 17, of which not more than 1/3rd sections may be used for senior secondary classes. Further increase shall require prior approval of the Board and compliance to affiliation by laws and availability of rooms of >500 ft.				
3	A ramp is seen on the outside of the building, but it is not clear as to whether it leads to successive floors in the building. Inside the building no ramp/lift is seen. The school shall mandatorily get it renewed every year and upload in the mandatory disclosure section on its website and update the status of certificate validity on OASIS every year.			
7	Failure to submit compliance to the above points within prescribed time shall invite financial penalty against the school.			
8	The school shall follow all SoPs of the Board for its labs, library and sports facilities.			
9	The school shall renew all mandatory certificates from time to time and shall not remove the mandatory disclosure section and videography links from its website.			
	The school shall conduct training of its teachers with coE Panchkula within 3 months and submit compliance on SARAS.
